

## WRITE A 150-200 WORD PARAGRAPH SYMBOL

*The above paragraph is only six words long, and you can count the words in this one if you like. In academic writing, paragraphs will usually consist of the “standard” • Is that the paragraph sign in the photo in this article?.*

On a separate piece of paper, note places where the essay does not seem to flow or you have questions about what was written. As Jorge reread his draft, he looked to see how the different pieces fit together to prove his thesis. Sometimes your ears catch inconsistencies that your eyes miss. You will begin the paragraph with an idea and then explain it in the light of currently accepted knowledge Phillips, with references. Tone is the attitude toward your subject and audience that you convey through your word choice. Have I included introductory material before any quotations? Did I want to read them? Decide how best to revise. Read the paper line by line as described in step 1. She looked for places where she needed to add a transition or perhaps reword the text to make the flow of ideas clear. Word Choice Note that word choice is an especially important aspect of style. A stuffy, overly formal tour guide can make readers feel put off or intimidated. Rather, you might try to compare apples and oranges. Copy editors are responsible for suggesting revisions and style changes; proofreaders check documents for any errors in capitalization, spelling, and punctuation that have crept in. This is applicable to blogs and web pages, and to a certain extent, in academic writing. Your concluding paragraph should pull together all the different elements of your definition to ultimately reinforce your thesis.
